



How much do pets cost?

You are talking to your parents about having a pet. After working out how much money is left in the budget every month, your parents tell you that there is £55 to spend on a pet per month

Please look at the costs per month of different pets and work out which pet would keep you within your budget

Animal	Food cost	Health cost	Other costs	Cost more or less than £55/month?
Dog	£20	£15 insurance £5 flea & worming £5 vaccinations	£21/month for kennels (based on 2 weeks away)	
Cat	£15	£10 insurance £5 flea & worming £4 vaccinations	Litter £8 £12/month for cattery (based on 2 weeks away)	
Rabbit	£15 + £10 for vegetables	£10	Woodshavings £10	
Hamster	£4	£6	Woodshavings £6	

Other costs may include excess on insurance, a dog walker, neutering, collar, lead, harness, organising a carer for rabbits and hamsters for holidays
